Satan deceives man


• Genesis 3

God tells us all that He is going to rescue mankind

• Genesis 3.15

# THE TWO VEINS OF HISTORY



#### The first is God's Kingdom

#### The second is satan's kingdom

#### There were two lines of attack

- to try and destroy the members of God's Kingdom
- to try to pervert the witness of God's Kingdom with apostasy and heresy

This conflict will rage until satan is finally thrown into the lake of fire

• *Revelation 20.7-10* 



#### ADAM'S THREE CHILDREN

Adam and Eve had two boys

• Cain and Abel

One was Godly, the other was not

• Cain killed Abel

Satan was the catalyst behind the murder

• 1 John 3.12

God overruled and gave them another son – Seth

 Seth is in the Godly line in Genesis 5



## THE FLOOD



Satan by this time had corrupted almost the entire population

• Genesis 6.5-7


Noah and his family, however, were not tainted by the corruption

• Genesis 6.8


God stopped the corruption, and gave mankind a new start

#### NOAH'S THREE CHILDREN








#### THE CREATION OF GOD'S NATION



#### THE BOY AND THE EXODUS



Amidst the turmoil God saved a boy named Moses

• Exodus 2.1-10

God used Moses to bring the 10 plagues upon Egypt and rescue the nation

• Exodus 7-14

Pharoah chased the nation, but God destroyed them

• Exodus 14

Satan tried to destroy the nation through starvation and drought

God both gave them water and provided quail

• Exodus 15-17



### THE COVENANT AND THE APOSTASY

God, at Mt. Sinai, gave Moses the Law

• Exodus 19-20

While Moses was on the mountain, Satan stirred up the people into idolatry

• Exodus 32.1-6

God told Moses to destroy the golden calf, and punished those that were involved

- Exodus 32.7-35
- About 3000 were killed verse 28



### THE TABERNACLE AND THE WANDERING

God gave instructions to build the tabernacle so the nation could worship Him

• Exodus 25-31

As they wandered through the wilderness, Satan attacked in many ways

Most spies were afraid of entering Canaan

• Numbers 13.31

God sent them back out in the wilderness for 40 years, killing off the complainers

• Numbers 14.11-35

Satan cause the nation to grumble, complain and turn against their leaders

God countered these things by making the nation victorious in battle

Satan tried to get Balaam to curse Israel

God caused Balaam to bless Israel

• Numbers 22-24

#### THE LAND

After the wandering, God brought the people into the land of Canaan

First, Egypt gave up control of the land

Second, God opened the waters of the Jordan so they could cross over

• Joshua 3

Third, Jehovah showed himself to Joshua and gave him encouragement

• Joshua 5.13-15

The people were to take all the land, and destroy all the inhabitants

• This would keep them from falling into idolatry and intermarrying with the other nations



## THE BATTLE OF JERICHO AND AI



#### God gave them Jericho

• Joshua 6

God told them not to keep anything, but one man did

Satan put it in the heart of Achan to keep some of the loot

• Joshua 7.1

Because of this sin, the Israelites lost the battle at AI

• Joshua 7.2-5

God had Joshua burn all the possessions of Achan, and they stoned him with stones

• Joshua 7.25

# THE JUDGES

The 350 years after the death of Joshua were marked by spiritual decline

• Judges 21.25

There were breakouts of apostasy in various areas of the nation, but not all at once

• Satan tried to make it like a flame that would catch on and grow

God raised up foreign nations to punish His people

Every time they would repent and return to God

• Judges 3.7 - 16.31

God also used the judges - like Deborah, Gideon, and Sampson



# SAMUEL AND THE KINGS

God then raised up a very strong leader named Samuel

• 1 Samuel 1-3

When Samuel was old, he placed his corrupt sons as judges

• 1 Samuel 8.1-4


This caused the people to clamor for a king

• 1 Samuel 8.5-9

The people had not rejected Samuel, but they rejected the LORD

• 1 Samuel 8.7

### KING SAUL



Saul was the first king, and he was good - at first

Satan turned his heart away from the LORD

- Abnormal self interest, insane jealousy and full apostasy
  - 1 Samuel 16.14-28.2; 29-30
- Saul consulted a spiritist
  - 1 Samuel 1 Samuel 28.3-25
- Lastly, he and his sons died in battle (Saul killed himself 31.4)
  - 1 Samuel 31

Thus, God ended the apostasy that could have grown from Saul

#### KING DAVID

#### David was then crowned King

He united the kingdom, made Jerusalem its capital, and put an end to Philistine domination of Israel


•2 Samuel 1-6

#### God established the Davidic Covenant

- David would have someone from his line on the throne forever
- David's kingdom would be forever the earthly kingdom

#### Satan would now attack David

## KING SOLOMON

God gave Solomon legendary wisdom

God allowed Solomon to build the Temple

• 1 Kings 5-6

Satan attacked and Solomon sinned:

Solomon built a large army - against God's command

• Deuteronomy 17.15-16

He had 700 wives and 300 concubines - against God's command

• 1 Kings 11.3

He married foreign women - against God's command

• 1 Kings 11.1-2

He made places to worship the foreign God's

• 1 Kings 11.4-8

This would split the kingdom in two:

- Jeroboam would take over 10 of the tribes
- Rehoboam would take the last 2 tribes those that the Messiah would come through

#### THE MID-TERM

God has an overarching plan for His people

Satan has an under-arching plan to destroy God's plan and God's people

It does not matter what Satan throws at you

Faith is diametrically opposed to Fear

- 1 John 4:18
- There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear. For fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not been perfected in love.
- 2 Timothy 1:7
- ... for God gave us a spirit not of fear but of power and love and self-control.
